### **Bio of Thomas Stocker, Professor Emeritus, University of Bern, Switzerland**

Thomas Stocker obtained a PhD in Natural Sciences of ETH Zürich in 1987. He did research in London, Montreal, New York and Honolulu. From 1993 to 2024 he was Professor of Climate and Environmental Physics at the University of Bern. Since 2025 he serves as President of the Ice Memory Foundation.

Thomas Stocker has authored or co-authored more than 290 peer-reviewed papers in climate dynamics and paleoclimate modeling and reconstruction. From 2008 to 2015 he served as Co-Chair of the UN Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change (IPCC) that provided the scientific foundation of the Paris Agreement.

Thomas Stocker holds two honorary doctorates of the University of Versailles and ETH Zürich, is member of several academies and was awarded numerous national and international awards.
